#### Light:

**Light** is a form of **energy** that travels in straight lines from a **source.** We need **light** in order to see things. **Darkness** is the absence of light.

## A Light Source:

A **Light Source** is something that gives off light.



### Reflection:

**Reflection** is when light hits a surface and bounces off.




## **Sunlight:**

Sunlight can damage our eyes so we shouldn't look directly at the sun.

Some objects are **opaque**which means they block
light. **Shadows** are caused
by **opaque** objects blocking
light.



#### Translucent

Some objects are translucent which means allow some light



#### Transparent

Some objects are transparent which means they allow light to pass through.
