- Can they spot any phase 2 or phase 3 'tricky' words in the text?

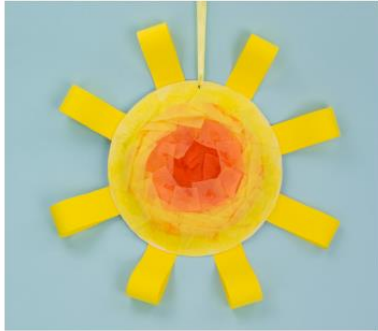
