Suggested ideas

Can you write your own picture book? Can you make sure there is a beginning, a middle and an end?

Can you list fairy tale characters? Can you segment the names independently and hear all key sounds?

Can you film a re-enactment of a traditional tale that you are familiar with? Can you make any resources to support you to re-tell the story?

Make a wish list of what you would like the 'Magic Beans' to grow into.

Build a fairy-tale castle using any available props or resources.

Fill a clear bottle with fairy-tale treasures! Seal the bottle and then label them imaginatively.

Can you make a gingerbread house using junk modelling resources?

Can you build a bridge for the 'Three Billy Goats Gruff'?

Can you make a story sack with the props and resources to re-tell the story 'Goldilocks and the three bears'?

Can you write a recipe of how to make porridge? Can you ensure you create step by step instructions?

Can you plant a seed and grow a beanstalk? Why not try and keep a seed diary to track the growth daily.
